| Ethics (AB 1234) Education Program | In September, the Board of Supervisors approved a change to the AB1234 training policy. Training is now required within one year of appointment and every two years thereafter. |

| | The OCEthics on-line training course in August had 26 attendees. |
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| Newly Elected and Appointed Official and Staff training program | This program is on hold until newly elected or appointed officials are sworn in. I continue to offer the training to all staff members of officials when requested. |
| Campaign Disclosure Review /Audits | Audits for the first disclosure of 2024 have been completed. Our audit process continues to allow review of all committees within 2 weeks. All committees provided requested information and voluntarily complied with any requests. No Notices of Violations were issued. |
| Education Outreach | One County ethics training was conducted for the Deputy Procurement Agents. Over 130 individuals attended. |

| Lobbyist Registration | As of September 30, 2024, there are a total of 79 active lobbyists. Registration and renewal revenues for 2024 remain consistent with previous years, amounting to approximately \$4,825. |
