

Responsibility	Status
Ethics (AB 1234) Education Program	As of January 31st, only one person had to be removed from their Commission. 2025 will be the first full year that the new compliance rule (training required every 2 years) will be applicable.
Newly Elected and Appointed Official and Staff training program	We have completed the training with Supervisor Nguyen and her staff.
Campaign Disclosure Review /Audits	Audits for the second disclosure of 2024 were completed in March. Two new committees were opened for the 2026 election with over \$300,000 in transfers. The 2025 filings are not due until July.
Education Outreach	No outside education took place this quarter.

Project	Status
Lobbyist Registration	The number of lobbyists has dropped. As of March 31, there are 66 lobbyists registered with the County.
Finance and Budget	The 2025-2026 budget for the office was submitted and sufficient funds were allocated to cover all anticipated expenses.
Complaint/Advice Program	No complaints within jurisdiction have been received in the first quarter. We continue to receive hundreds of emails from the same individual who sent more than 170 last quarter. We continue to receive multiple calls or emails a week for advice. These inquiries are usually simple to respond to and do not require significant research time. A significant amount of time this quarter was spent on drafting the response to the Board Directive concerning best practices for a Code of Ethics.
